Local Crime Update

Over the past month there have been five reported crimes and two suspicious incident within the Ward. (I cannot give details of full registration numbers due to data protection).

- 1) **Scagglethorpe** – Between 30th. Sept & 4th. Oct. Burglary at caravan on old A64.
- 2) **Westow** – Overnight 3rd. / 4th. Oct. Damage caused to motor vehicle whilst parked at Middlefield House.
- 3) **Thornthorpe** – Between 16th. / 18th. Oct. Report of vehicles being driven around fields at Whitegrounds.
- 4) **Howsham** – Between 15th. & 18th. Oct. Entry gained to workshop at Town Farm Cottage. Two motor cycles and associated clothing stolen.
- 5) **Leavening** – 18th. Oct. White four –wheeled drive vehicle seen in suspicious circumstances in field near to Beech House.
- 6) **Scagglethorpe** – Overnight 19th. / 20th. Oct. Burglary at caravan on old A64
- 7) **Westow** – Overnight 24th. / 25th. Oct. Trailer and tools stolen from Tarrs Yard.
